- < Assist in the development of learning outcomes and development of quantitative and qualitative data collection methods, e.g., focus groups and surveys as it relates to the Community Learning Model (Residential Curriculum)
- < Identify opportunities and develop ideas for learning initiatives targeted for each student classification (first-year, sophomore, junior, senior, transfer, and first-generation students).
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
