Required Revision of ODU Faculty Senate Constitution to Integrate EVMS Faculty

Description of Issue\* The Old Dominion University (ODU) and Eastern Virginia Medical School (EVMS) share much in common including a strong history of collaboration; renowned experts in our respective disciplines; complementary cultures; proven track records of emphasizing diversity, equity, and inclusion; and a deep commitment to making the Hampton Roads community a better place to live. ODU and EVMS have agreed to merge, and this strategic integration will create the largest health sciences center in the Commonwealth of Virginia and a regional medical and scientific hub.
